## THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN CONTRACTING A PAINTING COMPANY

You have decided to paint your home. This can be a large expenditure and should be considered an investment in maintaining the value of your home. With this in mind the following are some points to consider when making the decision on which painting company to hire.

- DOES THE CONTRACTOR HAVE A CURRENT LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY? This is required to avoid you having to make a claim against your homeowner's policy in the event damage should occur to your home by the painting contractor, his employees or sub-contractors. **Bill Bolton Painting carries \$2,000,000.00 coverage with Aviva Insurance Company.**
- DOES THE CONTRACTOR HAVE WORKPLACE SAFETY & INSURANCE BOARD CLEARANCE (W.S.I.B.)? This should be required by the homeowner in the event of an injury by the painting contractor, his employee or sub-contractors. Without this coverage if someone working on your property is injured, you could be sued by the injured worker for his losses. **Bill Bolton Painting stays current with my W.S.I.B. clearance at all times.**
- WHAT QUALITY OF PAINT IS BEING USED? Paint can be purchased from many retailers. For instance a paint purchased from some large retail locations manufactured by Pittsburgh Paints may not be the same quality as the paint of the same name purchased from a franchised store such as Ken Nash Paint in Welland or from the Dulux stores. In addition all paint manufacturers have several lines of residential paint priced from about \$25.00 up to \$71.00 a gallon. Generally, it is believed the cost of paint reflects the quality of the paint. If you expect paint to look better, clean better, give more years of looking good or perform better in any other way it will require a higher price per gallon to be paid. **Bill Bolton Painting uses several of the major paint suppliers however in almost all projects I only use the top 2 lines of paint.**
- DOES THE PAINTING CONTRACTOR HAVE A WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF HOW TO USE PAINT? For instance how to apply the new paint over the existing paint to ensure great results with the finish appearance in respects to smooth uniform finish. Will the paint being applied bond to the existing paint so as not to peel? **There are many scenarios to consider. You should discuss this with your potential contractor prior to making a final decision.**
- DOES YOUR PAINTER PROVIDE THE HEAVY LIFTING TO MOVE APPLIANCES, FURNITURE, WINDOW COVERINGS &/OR OTHER ARTICLES FROM WALLS ETC.? **Bill Bolton Painting does.**

## STANDARD PRACTICES WE INCORPORATE INTO OUR PROJECTS TO PROVIDE A BETTER VALUE

- Caulk all open joints when paint is applied to both surfaces to provide a clean professional appearance.
- Use painters tape to provide straight lines on trim for doors, windows and baseboards. This also helps to protect the surface from paint spray when it occurs and it allows us to roll closer to the trim for a uniform appearance.
- We use painters drop sheets to protect floors.
- In the event some paint specs do get on a surface (eg. hard surface floor or carpet) I have the knowledge to be able to remove the spots.
- All cracks in walls, ceilings and trim will be repaired.
- All divots, nicks, gouges, nail holes, screw pops will be repaired as we find them. You are encouraged to point out any we missed prior to the completion of the project.
- I will work with you to help select colours and provide you with test samples painted on the walls where appropriate to help ensure the right colour is chosen prior to starting the project. This includes paint and my time to provide up to 2 colour options. Additional options may be charged at a nominal fee.
- Don't be shy about asking questions. When the painting project is complete you want to have everyone working safe, smart and competent.
